Lord, you have brought blessings to everyone, bring us to share your concern for the good of all.

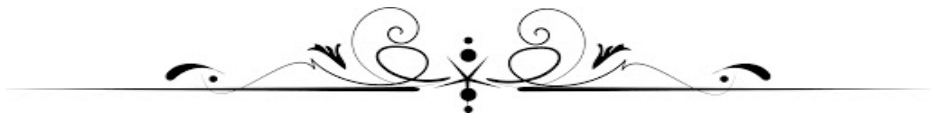

The Lord's Prayer

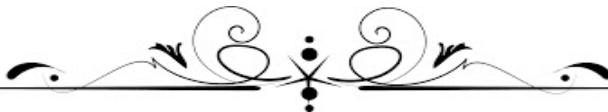
Final Prayer:
