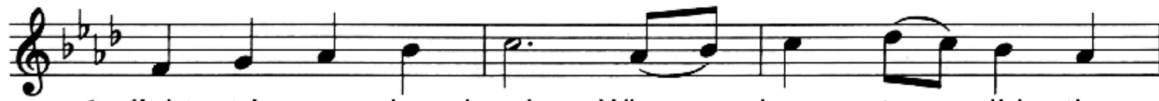

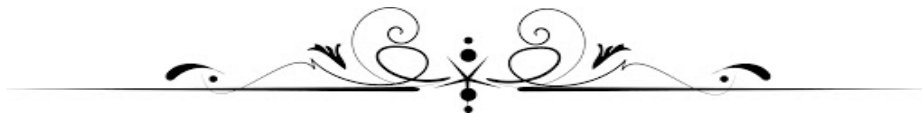

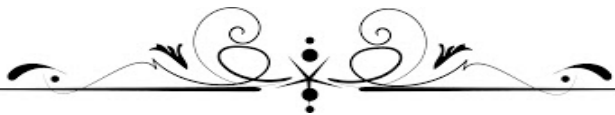

The Lord of a kingdom that lasts for ever, al-le-LU-ia.

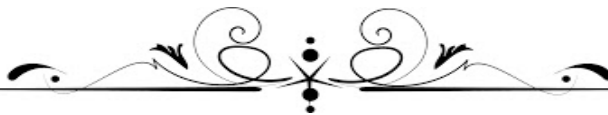
Psalm 149

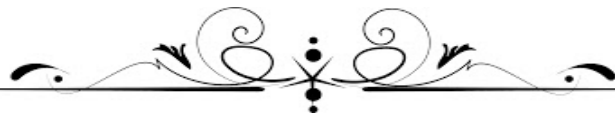


Luke 1:68-79

to our fa-ther A-braham: *(cont.)*

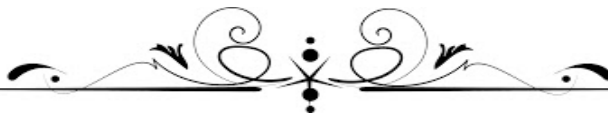




- 2 to set us free from the hands of our EN-emies,

Make us walk this day in holiness, and live upright and devout lives in this world.

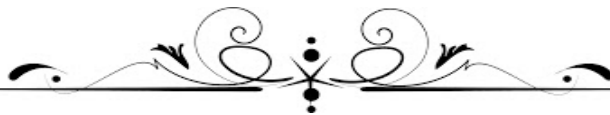
all respond: **Come and stay with us, Lord.**
